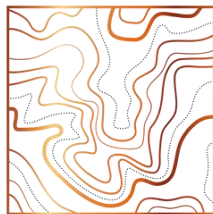
Bonnezeaux - Clos des Melleresses 2022

The 2022 Clos des Melleresses wine from Domaine des Petits Quarts has just won the Gold Medal at the 2025 General Agricultural Competition of Paris. This year, 3,361 wines were awarded prizes out of 12,238 samples.

Clos des Melleresses is an exceptional plot of vines, cultivated on the characteristic phthanite stones of a south-facing slope with an incline of up to 30%. This wine aged in oak barrels, is striking for its aromatic power, offering a dense nose dominated by aromas of candied white fruits and a silky palate.

Domaine des Petits Quarts is a winery established in 1887 by the Godineau family, located in the village of Bellevigne-en-Layon. The estate is historically renowned for its sweet and syrupy wines from the Bonnezeaux and Coteaux du Layon appellations. In 2004, its Bonnezeaux 1996 won the title of best sweet wine in the world. After a handover in 2021, the estate is now owned by 4 friends from Anjou, who are committed to perpetuating this precious winemaking know-how.





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Coteaux du Layon - Tentation 2024

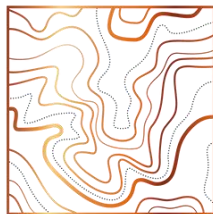
Our Coteaux du Layon Tentation 2024 received the Gold Medal at the 2025 General Agricultural Competition of Paris. This year, 3,361 wines were awarded prizes out of 12,238 samples.

The Coteaux du Layon Tentation stands out for its supple, smooth, and airy palate, as this sweetness is closer to a beautiful tenderness than a sweetness. Aromas of apricot and mango, with a hint of candied lemon and lemongrass, enhance the tactile freshness of the finish, providing a beautiful balance of flavor.

Anjou Dry White – Burnizellus 2023

The Burnizellus wine received the Grand Gold Medal at the Concours des Ligiers in 2025. It featured 2,000 samples of wines produced along the Loire River.

The Burnizellus grapes come from Clos des Melleresses, an exceptional plot of vines grown on the characteristic phthanite stones of a south-facing slope with an incline of up to 30%. This wine benefits from a year of aging in jars on lees, which reinforces the impression of yeast, along with the mineral notes of its volcanic terroir. The palate is dense, with a full structure, and a salinity that makes the mouth water and lends a long finish.

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
